





SELECTION PROCESS: CHOOSE WHAT GETS PUBLISHED

MUST SHOW EMOTION MUST HAVE A FOCAL POINT SUCCESSFUL COMPOSITION **MUST DRAW THE VIEWER IN GOOD COLOR/CONTRAST/LIGHT NO DISTRACTING ELEMENTS** NOT BLURRY

SOME IMAGES CAN BE EDITED BUT ELIMINATE THE PHOTO IF:

IT'S BLURRY THE LIGHTING IS TOO POOR IT'S NOT INTERESTING DOES NOT SHOW A FACE IT'S UNFLATTERING
