OBJECTIVES:

STEPS:

DO NOW: 3 minutes Find your partner, gather any props/accessories, review plans and locations. Decide who is shooting first.

LECTURE: 5-10 minutes

Review camera procedures, composition techniques, and rules for shooting outside the classroom.

ACTIVITY: Photo Shoot - 15 minutes for each partner, 30 minutes total

Tell your partner's story through 7 photos using a variety of composition and lighting techniques. Include one posed portrait, one group portrait, and the rest should appear candid.

CLOSURE: 10 minutes

Students will peer review each other's work and schedule more time for additional shooting if necessary.
